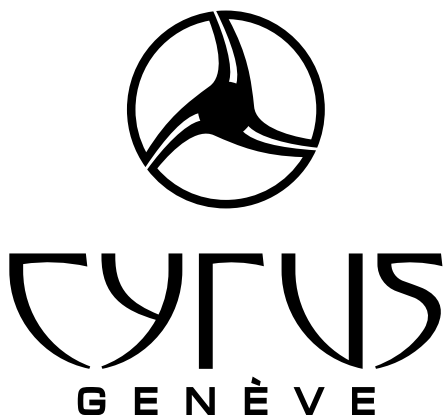

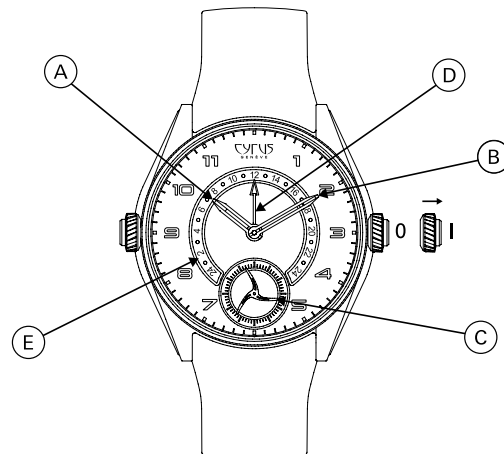

CONTROLS AND INDICATIONS

- A. Hours hand (local time)
- B. Minutes hand (local time)
- C. Seconds hand
- D. Jumping retrograde hours hand (home time)
- E. 24-hour dual time display



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Crown at 3 o'clock

WINDING THE WATCH

Position "0"

Turn the crown clockwise to wind the watch. When the movement is fully wound (about 45 turns of the crown), a power reserve of 55 hours is granted. The automatic movement allows the watch to wind up by simply using the energy produced by the wearer's own movement.

If the watch stops, you need to wind it manually by turning the crown.

SETTING THE TIME

Position "I"

Pull out the crown in position "I" for the time setting of the three hands: local time (A), minutes (B) and home time (D).

The three hands rotate simultaneously. The hands turn clockwise and counterclockwise. Lock of the 3 hands (A-B-D) in counterclockwise correction when the home time retrograde hand (D) reaches 12.00 o'clock AM (hand with triangular tip on the numeral 24 on the left of the 24h display (E)).

Seconds hand (C) requires no adjustment

Crown at 9 o'clock

QUICK SETTING OF THE MAIN TIME (Local Time)

Pressing the pusher on the crown results in the local time hand (A) moving forward by one hour jump to set the desired time (quick setting when arriving to a new destination).

During the local time adjustment, the home time (D) and minutes hands (B) of the local time remain unchanged.

Finally, to ensure that you enjoy your CYRUS Genève watch for a lifetime, we recommend that you have it checked and serviced by an official representative of the brand every three years.
